Our aim is to provide as many children as possible with their very own Afghan traditional tales in illustrated Dari-Pashto editions.

For at least 95% of these children, these will be the first books they own, and they may well be tales that their grandparents recognize from their childhood.

Thanks to a Public Diplomacy Grant from the US Department of State our implementing partners Khatiz Organization for Rehabilitation (KOR) are printing and distributing over 2.4 million books to children in schools and orphanages throughout the country.

But we still have a waiting list and the capacity to print and distribute more. With your help we can do so!

In Afghanistan, there is a literacy rate of only 28% for Afghans over 15 years old. Afghanistan has the highest proportion of school-age (ages 7-12) children in the world, yet almost half (5 million) of them have no access to education. Schools have very limited resources and books are rare.

Give a young girl a book of her own - she will find someone to help her read it.



For every \$100 donated, 83 Afghan children will receive a beautifully illustrated book to keep.

Imagine a young child returns home to read a tale that her grandfather recognizes, and then is able to write down another that he dictates to her from his memory of Afghanistan's rich storytelling tradition.

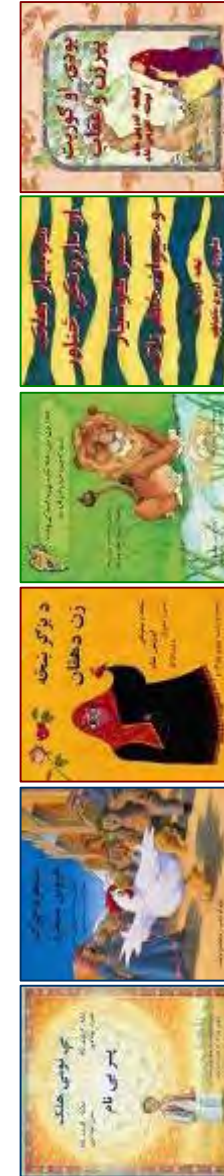
